## Required Products

The green cleaning requirements established by the state of Illinois require that schools purchase green cleaning products in six categories: bathroom cleaners; carpet cleaners; general purpose cleaners; glass, window and mirror cleaners; hand cleaners and hand soaps; and paper products. The following listings include the products provided by Momar that meet the relevant standards for each category.

### General Purpose Cleaners

*Illinois Green Clean Schools guidelines require that general purpose cleaners used in schools meet standards set by Green Seal, Environmental Choice, or U.S. EPA Design for the Environment.*

#### Envision

*Design for the Environment*

Ultra-Concentrated Neutral Cleaner. Safe on all flooring surfaces. Removes soapy build-up. Emulsifies greases and oils. Will not strip or harm finished floors. Safe in floor scrubbers. Dilutes up to 1:256. Meets USDA A-1 guidelines.

#### Neutrox

*Design for the Environment*

Ultra-Concentrated Neutral Cleaner with Peroxide. The true total facility cleaner. Safe on all surfaces, including carpet, glass, metal, plastic, vinyl, tile, marble, and wood. Emulsifies greases and oils. Will not strip or harm finished floors. Safe in floor scrubbers. Color-safe bleaching and deodorizing. Dilutes up to 1:128. Meets USDA A1 guidelines.

The green cleaning guidelines include recommendations for products that go beyond the law's requirements. While the law requires that schools purchase and use green cleaning products in the previous six categories, it recommends (but does not require) that schools use green cleaning products and practices in a broad range of additional categories. The guidelines' authors explain that in addition to meeting the requirements, "schools may wish to implement a more comprehensive green cleaning program and are encouraged to do so."
